# Kingsburg Tri County Health Care District Kingsburg Youth Baseball Association (KYBA) Proposal Options

#### **Background & Future Prospect for Hank Hash Field**

Kingsburg Youth Baseball Association (KYBA) was blessed last year with a generous grant from the governing board of KTCHD for the amount of \$410,000. KYBA has been pushing the project forward by receiving city help with a land donation/lease agreement, engineering master design plans, irrigation designs, small cash donations, fund raising for a brick campaign, and receiving material donation in irrigation piping for underground utilities for the complex. KYBA had applied for an additional grant from the Hillblom Foundation to complete the entire large scale of the project for \$194,000, but were unsuccessful in obtaining this grant.

With the 2020 season and fundraising efforts at a total stop due to the Covid-19 outbreak, KYBA scaled the project down to its bare bones just to get a playing field for the 2021 season. The project would include a mulita use baseball field, fencing, bleachers, lighting, irrigation, grass/sod, and a score board. Over time, KYBA would still be able to add a snack facility with restrooms, additional fencing, sidewalks, shade structures and a full parking lot in the years to come with our current master plan that we have in place.

### **Summary:**

If approved by KTCHD the reallocation of \$160,000 in current funding, A & B this would cover the cost of construction and installation of the entire lighting system from Techline Sports Lighting (TSL). It would also still be able to provide bleacher structures and all field equipment to play baseball.

KYBA will receive a donation from Streamline Irrigation Inc. that would provide all underground piping for the water main and irrigation, but will not provide the construction, labor and installation for the irrigation heads. Kingsburg's Green & Clean Landscaping & Construction will construct this section of the grounds. This option while scaled down, would provide a playing field that would be ready for the 2021 Season for our organization.

This option would complete the project as designed to include a full functioning baseball field, restrooms, snack facilities, shade structures, The additional funding would also include sod, irrigation, scoreboard, outer sidewalks around complex, a fully paved parking lot, all underground utilities for lighting, PG&E design and power to the Hank Hash Complex.
