Whereas the Kingsburg Health Care (“District” or “KHC”) is a local public agency existing under the Local Health Care District Law (the “Act”). (Health and Safety Code §§ 32000 *et seq.*)

Whereas, on May 8, 2024 of, the governing Board of the Directors of The Kingsburg Health Care District (“Board”) considered various grant applications and based upon its desire to make available to the residents of the District, the Board selected several Grant applications and based upon its desire to make available important services to the residents of the District. The board select several grant applications for a final approval pending receipt of additional information.

Whereas, Board Member Lori Sanders, announced (on her own) that the Board and community members not discussed grants approved or denied in open session with no official approval of understanding.

First amendment allows all people in public meetings freedom of Speech.

Whereas, The meeting June 12,2024 raised concerns of a public citizen’s comments made outside of the meeting relating to board business. Sander’s disruption happened in the public meeting under Action Items #16. Which all heard.

Ms. Sanders directed questions pondering the community member/City Council Member to admit he was the one that had done wrong. Sanders continued to question him in a public meeting. This was based on hearsay. Note: Community and Board members have the right to talk to any one outside of the board meeting.

Therefore, the Board of Directors issues this letter of guidance for the following reasons:

1. Lori Sanders spoke out of order as a board member, to the community and board.
2. Treat all community members with dignity and respect, even in the face of criticism and opposition.
3. Treat all board members and staff with dignity and respect

Lori Sanders this behavior is not tolerated while representing the Kingsburg HealthCare District.
