Community Needs Request: Back to School Health Fair for Kingsburg Elementary Charter District Families and the Community of Kingsburg

Requested by: Kingsburg Community Educational Foundation and Kingsburg Elementary Charter School District representative, Linda Simmons, Community Schools Coordinator.

Request: \$3000.

1. Project Overview: Describe in detail how the funds will promote health and wellness and further the District's goal of fostering quality health services and programs that benefit the residents of the District.

The event promotes health and wellness among students, families, and the broader Kingsburg community, aligning with the Kingsburg Health Care District's mission to foster quality health services and programs that benefit local residents.

The event will expand its offerings by including all of last year's booths and adding several new partners and services to broaden its impact. Community organizations and providers expected to participate include:

- **Fresno County Department of Public Health Mobile Health Clinic, United Health Center, Adventist Health Clinic, and Valley Health Team**, all of which will provide direct medical services and health screenings.
- Mental and behavioral health support will be offered through **All 4 Youth and Beyond the Bell**.
- **KCAPS (Kingsburg Community Assistance Program)** will connect families with vital local resources.
- Other participants include the **Healthy Smiles Dental Bus, nutrition education booths, and WIC (Women, Infants, and Children program)**, which will provide essential health education and preventive care resources.
- Safety and wellness partners include the **Kingsburg Police Department, Kingsburg Fire Department, Cal/OSHA, and ICAC (Internet Crimes Against Children)**.

By hosting this event with support from the **FCSS Mobile Health Unit**, local medical providers, dental and vision professionals, mental health providers, and the **KECSD Health Team**, the goal is to eliminate barriers to school readiness, such as missing immunizations, incomplete medical, dental, and vision screenings, and lack of physician authorizations. The event also promotes overall wellness by once again hosting a **free farmers market/food pantry pickup** to ensure families have access to healthy food. The grant proposal states that the fair is a strategic response that brings essential services directly to families before the first day of school, promoting equity, improving student attendance and readiness, and strengthening family-school-community relationships.

Total Project Costs:

- Marketing/Outreach and Event Materials: \$1,000
- Venue Preparation, Maintenance, and Staffing: \$1,000
- Participant Food: \$3,000
- Participant Entertainment and Amenities: \$1,000
- Total Project Cost for 2025: \$6,000

Explanation of Need: This fair is a strategic response that brings essential services directly to families before the first day of school. It promotes equity, improves student attendance and readiness, and strengthens family-school-community relationships.

Previous Funding Sources:

- In 2024, Kingsburg Health Care District funded the first Health Fair with **\$5,000**. KECSD covered the remaining costs.
- In 2025, Kingsburg Health Care District funded the second Health Fair with \$3,000. KECSD covered the remaining costs.

Current Funding Source (Requested):

- The request is for a **50% match** from the Kingsburg Health Care District (\$3,000), with the remainder covered by KECSD.

Kingsburg Elementary Charter School District is committed to funding 50% of this event. Contributions include:
